Built in 1791-1795

Originally it was the city palace of the family von der Leyen (textile manufacturing)

Capacity today: 400 offices 500 city employees

In other locations: about 3500 city employees

GREEN CITY








More than 3200 acres of forest, mostly owned by the City of Krefeld

Several historical parks for recreation

"Stadtwald" (city forest) as a meeting point, especially in the summer



CITY CENTRE



Clear structure of the city centre: four leafy streets, where the city walls once stood

Decentral development instead of one large shopping mall

Some examples of great architecture in spite of huge destructions during the war





Rich and varied culture scene with several museums, theatres and locations for concerts

Krefeld has an avant-garde tradition, thanks to the wealthy silk manufacturers who brought contemporary artists to Krefeld

Large collection of modern art from the 20th and 21st century

Burg Linn: Castle and archeological museum – part of the UN world heritage "Limes Germanicus" (line of frontier fortifications of the Roman Empire)

Municipal theatre with drama, musical theatre, ballet and symphonic orchestra



SPORTS



Huge variety of sports teams in the city: football, handball, hockey, ice hockey, tennis – and also American Football ("Krefeld Ravens")

Athletes from Krefeld have recently won quite a lot of Olympic medals, e.g. rowing, hockey and women's wrestling






MOBILITY HUB

BIKING ROUTE THROUGH THE CITY



City is cooperating with a citizens' initiative: The old bath could be turned into a center for cultural purposes, small businesses and voluntary work









DEVELOPMENT IN RECENT YEARS

On average about 7.5 percent of young people (15-25 years) in Krefeld are looking for a job. Around 15 percent of them have been looking for more than a year.

VOCATIONAL TRAINING IN GERMANY

- $\circ~$ vocational training usually takes three years
- the apprentice spends part of his training in his firm or craft business and two days per week in specialized schools ("Berufsschule")
- for many years there have been more open places of work for training than applicants
- → still usually about 200-300 young people don't find a place for vocational trainings
- \rightarrow they have no real perspective for their professional life
- → in most cases they have la low school degree (9 years of school, "Hauptschulabschluss") or none at all



HOW WE FIGHT YOUTH UNEMPLOYMENT

- \circ early support
 - every high school student has to do several internships at an early age
 - the internships last from one day (short looks into job life) up to three weeks
- $\circ~$ coaching and counseling
 - towards the end of school life those students, who aim for a low degree, get supported and counceled by experts
 - those experts also accompany the transmission period between school and professional life



HOW WE FIGHT YOUTH UNEMPLOYMENT



- immediate measures
 - those who cannot find a vocational training are brought into contact with companies still looking for apprentices (e.g. through "speed dating")




HOW WE FIGHT YOUTH UNEMPLOYMENT

- replacement measures
 - the City of Krefeld, the job agency (federal institution) and the guilds are working together to take care of those who haven't found a place
 - they can learn a trade (e.g. electrician, carpenter) in specialized workshops owned by the city or the guilds (with the option to chance to a "real" company later)



THE CITY OF KREFELD AS A ROLE MODEL



Number of apprentices - City of Krefeld

- number of apprentices has doubled since 2018 (five times as many compared to 2014)
- 26 different professions (from 2023: 32)
- in 2021 there were 2182 applications for those jobs
- $\circ~$ in the future number of apprentice will rise to almost 200 $\,$
